SUBJECT: Information regarding the processing of personal data of users who visit CELME SRL website and the use of cookies, with regards to the protection of personal data pursuant to article 13 of Regulation EU 2016/679.

PRIVACY - USE OF COOKIES

We wish to inform you the EU REG. 2016/679 (GDPR) provides for the protection of subjects with regards to the processing of personal data. According to the above indicated regulations, such processing will be based on the principles of correctness, lawfulness, transparency, and the protection of your privacy and your rights. Pursuant to article 13 of EU REG. 2016/679 (GDPR), we therefore provide you with the following information.

WHAT COOKIES ARE

Cookies are small strings of text that the sites visited by the user send to the user's terminal (usually to the browser), where they are stored and then retransmitted to the same sites the next time the same user visits them. When browsing a site, the user can also receive cookies that are sent from different sites or web servers (so-called "third parties"), which may include elements such as images, maps, sounds, specific links to pages of other domains) present on the site that the user is visiting. The two macro-categories are: "technical" cookies and "profiling" cookies.

Technical/analytical cookies

These cookies are used for the sole purpose of "transmitting a communication over an electronic communications network, or to the extent strictly necessary for the provider of an information company service explicitly requested by the subscriber or user to provide that service. They are not used for other purposes and are normally installed directly by the owner or operator of the website. They can be divided into navigation or session cookies, which guarantee normal navigation and use of the website (allowing, for example, to make a purchase or confirm your identity to access restricted areas); analytics cookies, assimilated to technical cookies when used directly by the site manager to collect information, in aggregate form, regarding the number of users and how they visit the site; functionality cookies, which allow the user to navigate according to a series of selected criteria (for example, language, products selected for purchase) in order to improve the service provided.

Prior consent of users is not required for the installation of these cookies, while the obligation to provide information pursuant to art. 13 of the GDPR regarding the protection of personal data remains, which the site operator, if he uses only such devices, will be able to provide in the manner he deems most suitable.

Profiling cookies

Profiling cookies are aimed at creating profiles related to users and are used to send advertising messages in line with the preferences expressed by the same when surfing the net.

European and Italian legislation provides that users must be adequately informed about their use and thus express their valid consent.

TYPES OF COOKIES USED BY CELME SRL

Technical/Analytical cookies

"Third party" cookies for marketing: used by third party companies and allow users to connect to third party sites for commercial purposes. Furthermore, these "third parties" could - in addition to what specified in this policy and also without the knowledge of the owner – carry out further user tracking activities. For detailed information in this respect, users are advised to consult the respective privacy policies of the services listed, in which users can receive information on the relative processing and express consent in this regard. The Data Controller reminds you that with regard to third-party cookies, the same has the sole obligation to insert the link to the third-party site in this cookie policy. It is the





responsibility of this subject, however, to create an appropriate disclosure regarding the processing carried out and to provide information to users on how to block the cookies used.

PURPOSE OF THE PROCESSING TO WHICH THE DATA IS INTENDED

The purposes for which cookies are used on our website are as follows:

- IT authentication,
- Session monitoring.

NATURE OF DATA PROVISION AND CONSEQUENCES OF REFUSAL TO RESPOND

With references to items 1), 2), the installation of these cookies is not subject to prior consent of users, being the same strictly necessary to carry out the transmission of communication on an electronic communications network. Processing will be carried out using automated systems designed to store and manage the data in accordance with the purposes indicated, and to guarantee the security and confidentiality of the data.

SCOPE OF COMMUNICATION AND DISCLOSURE OF DATA

With regards to the aforementioned purposes, data may be communicated to:

- all persons whose right of access to such data is recognised by law;
- to our collaborators, employees and suppliers, in the context of their duties and/or contractual obligations with them, concerning commercial relations with the interested parties.

No provision is foreseen for the distribution of data other than by express consent.

RIGHTS REFERRED TO IN ART. 15 OF EU REGULATION 2016/679

The interested subject has the right to obtain from the Data Controller confirmation that his/her personal data concerning is being processed and, in this case, to obtain access to said personal data and to the following information:

- a) the purposes of the processing;
- b) the categories of personal data concerned;
- c) the recipients or categories of recipients to whom the personal data has been or will be disclosed, in particular if these are recipients from third party countries or international organizations;
- d) whenever possible, the retention period of personal data provided envisaged or, if not possible, the criteria used to determine this period;
- e) e) the existence of the right of the interested party to request that the data controller rectify or delete personal data, limit the processing of his/her personal data, or to oppose its treatment;
- f) the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority;
- g) if the data is not collected from the interested party, all information available regarding its origin;
- h) the existence of an automated decision-making process, including the profiling referred to in Article 22, paragraphs 1 and 4, and, at least in such cases, significant information regarding the logic used, as well as the importance and expected consequences of such treatment for the interested party.
